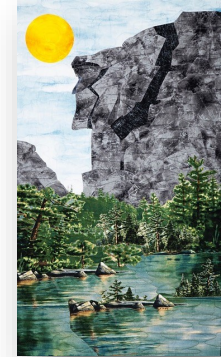

OPEN TO ALL ARTISTS—MEMBERS AND NON-MEMBERS

ORIGINALS ONLY FOR COMPETITION—no prints

You may enter this show in one of two ways

Option 1.

Entering with your Screens Set-Up- for ten full days of showing

- **members** \$50
- **non-members** \$100 (New Members may join at any time (\$25)).
- You may set up 3 display panels, a print bin and a greeting card display rack.
- You may enter up to three artworks for the competition.
- Artwork entered in the competition will be hung on your screen after the judging.
- Every item should be clearly marked with name, price, media and any necessary information.
- An inventory of your display must be submitted at setup.
- A 25% Commission will be taken on all sales. No price on request.
- Artists participating in this show are required to be monitors for a minimum of two hours.



Option 2.

Entering one to three pieces of Artwork for ten days of showing

- **members** \$10 donation for each artwork to total 3.
- **non-members** \$20 donation for each artwork to total 3.
- You may enter up to three (3) artworks.
- **A minimum of one entry must be for sale.**
- Overall size limit for artwork 48" W X 48" H.
- Participants may display: prints, matted work & cards (no extra chg. to use AIGMV bins and racks.)
- Every item should be clearly marked with name, price, media and any necessary information. A complete inventory list must be submitted at set up.
- A 25% commission will be taken on all sales. No price on request.
- Artists participating in this show are required to be monitors for a minimum of two hours.

Pick-up is Saturday, October 28, 2017 from 1 to 2 P/M

Categories will be determined once entries are received.
